Merchant Fee must be paid with application. Registration deadline is July 11, 2005.

Set up begins at 1:00 PM Friday, July 29, 2005. This is for merchants only.

No tear down during closing court on Sunday. You may tear down before or after but not during.

All merchants are to be off site by 6:00 PM Sunday night.

Each person is ultimately responsible for the security and safety of their own booth, tent and property.

Cash or merchandise donations are strictly voluntary and will be gratefully accepted anytime during the event. Any merchant wishing to donate, simply needs to contact the merchant-crat.

The amount of the donation (if any) is voluntary and no solicitations of funds will take place on site.

Potable water will be available on site. Limited electrical may be available. You must provide your own extension cords. Priority will be given to food merchants for electricity.

The gate fee will be as follows:

Pre-Registration: Adults \$12.00, Youth \$8.00 (13-17), Children \$6.00 (6-12), children 5 and under are Free, Family Cap \$35.00 and Non-SCA member surcharge \$3.00 (per adult).

Fees at the gate: Adults \$15.00, Youth \$10.00 (13-17), Children \$8.00 (6-12), children 5 and under are Free, Family Cap \$45.00 and Non-SCA member surcharge \$3.00 (per adult)
